It begins by discussing the Intervention Assistance Team and what occurs at the assistance team meeting. It also explains that to begin the multifactorial evaluation process, the parent must complete a Request for Parent Consent for Evaluation. A multifactorial evaluation is described as a way to gather information from many sources about the student s strengths, needs, and learning styles. Members of the evaluation team are listed and include the student s parent, the student s teacher, a person qualified to conduct individual diagnostic assessment of children, and one or more individuals who has knowledge of the suspected disability, along with typical child development and the general education curriculum.
